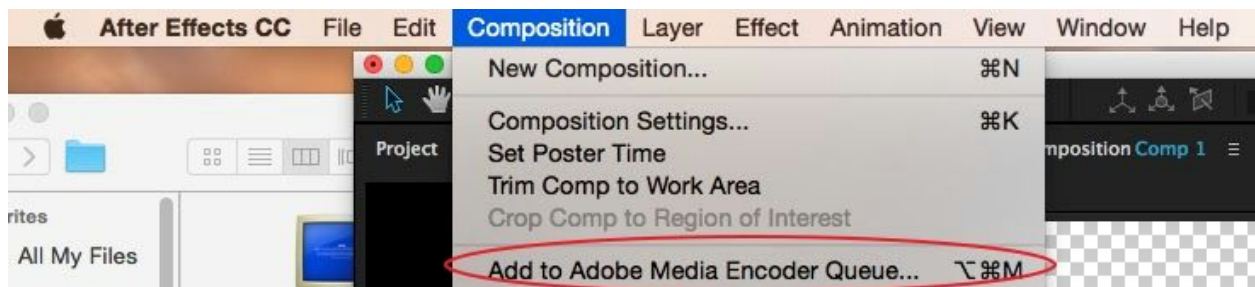


# Exporting Clips/Animations for Clipstore with Transparency

## Exporting from After Effects to Media Encoder

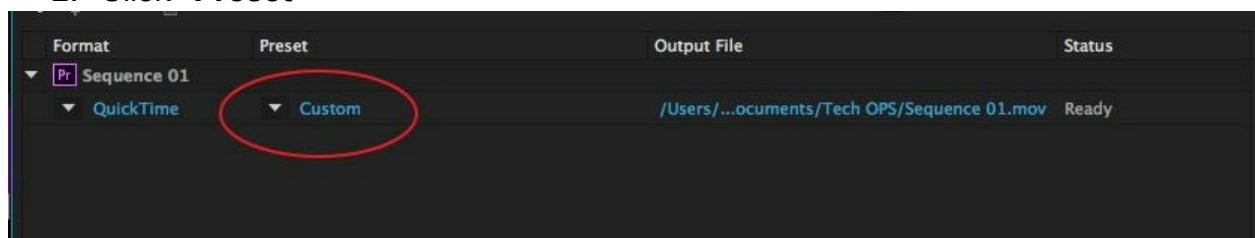
(If coming from Premiere, skip this step)

1. In the menu bar at the top of the screen, click “**Composition**”
2. Then click “**Add to Adobe Media Encoder Queue**”



## Finding Export Settings in Adobe Media Encoder

1. Find your file in the Media Encoder Queue
2. Click “**Preset**”



## Export Settings In Media Encoder

- Format: **Quicktime**
- Video Codec: **Apple ProRes 4444**
- Width: **1920**
- Height: **1080**
- Frame Rate: **29.97**
- Field Order: **Progressive**
- Aspect: **Square Pixels (1.0)**
- Depth: **64 Bit** \*\*\*\**This is what makes it transparent*\*\*\*\*

\*\*\*If you are editing in the green room, simply select the **Format** as **Quicktime** and the **Preset** as **Clipstore Transparent**
